### Heritage

Portobello Library catalogue, also called **Heritage**, is available online, both in the Library and remotely. You can search by author, title or subject area or a combination of all three. To access Heritage online go to

<https://heritage.portobellocollege.ie>

and log on using the same username and password as you do for the computer network. When you log on to Heritage your name will appear on the top left-hand side of the page. Click on your name to see a list of the texts you have out on loan - you can then renew them. Please note that

books cannot be renewed online if they are overdue.

## **Off-Campus Databases**

Our off-campus databases include **Lexis-Nexis** which is a very useful online resource not only for business information but especially for international legal material.

For remote access to **Lexis-Nexis**, log on to the Dublin Business School website

[www.dbs.ie](http://www.dbs.ie)

go to **Student Life**, then **Library**. Click on **Off Campus Databases** (under **general information**) and then on **Lexis-Nexis Professional**. You will then be asked for your username and \*password:

Username: DBSLEXISNEXIS  
Password: CARMEL123  
or  
PASS123

\*please note that these passwords seem to alternate, so if CARMEL123 doesn't work try PASS123

As you will see, Lexis-Nexis has a new platform which has been divided into two completely separate sections - business and law. The new interfaces are much more user-friendly so should make searching easier!

The **Emerald** database is also available under **Off Campus Databases** on the Dublin Business School website. Portobello College students use the following logon:

Username: **portobellocoll**  
Password: **emerald**
